**Submission of papers:** Use the online form available at <http://sef.ufms.br/vii/trabalhos> **Format:** Work document (.doc); A4 size, arial font size 12; space between lines 1.5; margins: top and left, 3 cm, right and bottom 2 cm; paragraph 1.25 cm, between 10 and 20 pages. **Title:** capitalized, bold and centralized. The title must be also be translated into Portuguese and Spanish (italics, the first letter in capitals and centralized). **Abstracts:** Between 50 and 150 words, in Portuguese, English and Spanish, with objectives, methodology and research results. **References:** ABNT standards NBR 6023.2018. **Author(s) identification:** on a separate page, inform full name and short CV (graduation, title, institution and e-mail) for each author.

**Posters presentation:** Use the online form available at the event's page on the TRABALHOS tab. Posters dimensions are 90cm x 80cm. Text format on two or three columns. Identification must include: title, authors, institutions. The authors are responsible for poster printing (in canvas, pvc, glosspaper or similar) and for its fixation (string, nails, tape...). One of the authors must be present at the poster session to discuss it with the interested parties and the Judging Committee. A poster template is available on the events page on the PAPERS tab.

**Book Launch:** On October 8<sup>th</sup> 2019, at 21:30, we'll hold cocktail and book launch session. Submit your Border Studies book through the submission form at the event page (<http://sef.ufms.br/vii>) on SUBSCRIPTION tab.
